The Municipality of South Huron invites applications for four (4) community members of South Huron's Heritage Advisory Committee.

Community members serving on an advisory committee provide advice and feedback to Council and assist Council in gathering and communicating community input on local issues.

The ideal Committee candidate:

- a resident of South Huron
 - consideration may be given to applicants who live outside of South Huron, if there are no other qualified applicants
- demonstrates an interest in the complexities, benefits and challenges of heritage preservation
- have special interest or knowledge in one or more of the following areas:
 - conducting research with respect to heritage and historical matters
 - architecture and urban design
 - restoration, conservation, construction practices related to heritage resources
 - local history, genealogy
 - historical public outreach and education
 - planning, land development and geography

The term of the Committee will be to the end of Council term (to 2026). Committee members must follow the Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee Terms of Reference. Committee Terms of Reference are available upon request. There will be at least three (3) meetings a year and at times members will work within tight timelines as prescribed within the Terms of Reference.
