**6. O.P.P. Report**

- Detailed reports were distributed prior to the meeting for review and to allow for effective discussion at the Board meeting
- Inspector/Interim Command Rob Scott provided a comprehensive overview and explanation of the September reports, including the Violent Crime, Property Crime and Drug Crime as well as the Clearance Rates, and Unfounded on each section
- Outline of Traffic Offenses and Statistics
- Reviewed Calls for service billing report
- Officers are completing Pro-Active Enforcement, continue to see impairments by drug and alcohol during road stops
- Inspector/Interim Commander Rob Scott will look into time frame for impairments, stated that it is not unusual to see early morning during the week impairments, becoming higher in the evenings during peak summer time. Drug impairment offenses are beginning to cycle through the courts similar to alcohol impairments. He will try to separate the drug from alcohol impairments on the next O.P.P Report
- Inspector/Interim Commander Rob Scott detailed a vehicle check blitz for locked cars. O.P.P checked over 1000 vehicles during the blitz, a considerable amount left unlocked with people continuing to leave keys in their vehicles. Also reported on media surrounding a Weapons Call in South Huron and Missing Person that were described in the September 2019 O.P.P Report
- Chair Dietrich would like to recognize officers for jobs well done as many of them live in our own communities
- Inspector/Interim Commander Rob Scott stated that he will send education and recognition pieces to the Clerk and Chair. Inspector/Interim Commander Scott also stated that there is an attempt to provide information on the expansion of social media in policing and the formation of a Community Safety team that could include a Media Officer, High School Resource Officer and Mobile Crisis Worker.
- Chair Dietrich confirmed he was receiving OPP media releases and will forward to the Board.
