The Municipality of South Huron invites applications for five (5) volunteer positions as members on the Age Friendly Community Steering Committee. The Committee's purpose is to provide Council with recommendations on matters regarding policies, services and structures related to physical and social environments that are designed to support and enable older people to live in a secure environment, enjoy good health and continue to participate fully in the community.

The Committee will actively assist Council by fostering and promoting the Age Friendly Community Plan to achieve the vision of:

- An inclusive and caring community that respects and values seniors
- A full range of services and facilities that meet the needs of seniors and all members of the community
- Seniors enjoying a balanced, active and engaged lifestyle in South Huron

Membership shall consist of the following:

- Up to two (2) members from South Huron Council
- Five (5) members of the public representing stakeholders in the community to be appointed by South Huron Council.

Selection criteria will include:

- Willingness and ability to commit to the necessary time-line;
- Commitment and interest in age friendly community initiatives;
- Ability to assist staff and Council with developing and implementing plans to raise knowledge, awareness and uptake of available services and activities for seniors in the community;
- Skills and experience related to previous work with community-based and/or planning projects;
- A reasonable assurance that the selected member does not have a pecuniary interest related to the work of the committee.

Prior to undertaking the duties of a Committee Member, each member is required to participate in a committee orientation and sign a confidentiality and code of conduct agreement.
