



Notice of Study Completion South Huron Water and Wastewater Master Plan

The Municipality of South Huron has completed a Water and Wastewater Master Plan to identify a comprehensive framework for necessary water and wastewater projects over a period of 20 years. The Master Plan is a component of the Municipality's strategic plan to maintain infrastructure and improve development opportunities within these settlement areas through an environmentally sensitive and sustainable framework for the provision of municipal services for existing and future development.

The Master Plan was undertaken in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Municipal Engineers Association, 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, and 2015) Master Planning Approach #2. Approach #2 allows for the preparation of a Master Plan at the completion of Phases 1 & 2 of the Class EA process, whereby the final notification serves as the Notice of Completion for Schedule B projects identified within the Master Plan.

By this notice, the Draft Master Plan document will be placed on public record for the statutory public review period from April 3, 2019 to May 3, 2019 at the following locations:

If concerns cannot be resolved with the project team within the review period, any interested party may request the Minister of Environment to issue an order to comply with Part II of the EA Act, elevating the status of the project.

Please note: Part II Order requests cannot be made against the entire Master Plan document, but only against Schedule B project identified within the Master Plan. The procedure for a "Part II Order" request is as follows:

The person with the concern shall make a written submission to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change, Floor 11, 77 Wellesley St. W Toronto ON M7A 2T5, Fax: 416-314-8452 and the Director, Environmental Approvals Branch, Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change 135 St. Clair Ave West, 1st Floor, Toronto ON M4V 1P5 with a copy to the Municipality of South Huron. This written request must be submitted to the Minister within the statutory review period after the proponent has filed the Master Plan document on public record and issued the Notice of Completion.

If no Part II Order requests are received, and subject to receipt of the necessary approvals, the Municipality of South Huron can proceed with design and implementation of projects identified within the Master Plan.
