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NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

LONDON ROAD SOUTH TRUNK SANITARY SEWER - CONTRACT NO. 25239

(SNIDER CRESCENT – 2026 CONSTRUCTION)

June 19, 2026

The Municipal Council for South Huron has awarded a contract for the London Road South Trunk Sanitary Sewer to Omega Contractors Inc.

B.M. Ross and Associates from Goderich are the engineers for the project.

Construction activities will commence at the Snider Sewage Pumping Station site (31 Snider Crescent) and on Snider Crescent in early July and is anticipated to be completed before December.

The construction work for this project on Huron and Mary Streets is tentatively scheduled for the 2027 construction season.

A Public Open House was held, Wednesday, June 10, 2026, at the Municipal office to answer questions from the public.

Prior to construction work beginning, a specialized sub-contractor, TBT Engineering (TBT) will be contacting each resident or owner within this year's construction zone, to schedule a brief voluntary pre-condition survey. The survey will include all buildings and properties (interiors and exteriors) to verify existing conditions prior to construction. Your participation in this survey is optional but highly recommended. TBT will start by delivering letters to property owners to schedule these surveys. This survey is to be completed to document pre-construction conditions of the properties to allow a comparison of conditions should a claim arise as a result of the construction operations. There is no cost to the property owner for this survey.

Water and sanitary service disruptions are expected for some properties but should be limited to one day (during construction hours), and a notice to residents will be provided in advance, whenever possible, for scheduled disruptions to service.

Once construction has begun, no on street or boulevard parking will be permitted within the construction zone for the duration of the project.

Efforts will be made to maintain reasonable access to driveways during construction. Access to driveways may at times be restricted and not always available depending on the construction activity. The contractor will notify the affected properties. With traffic disrupted and detours in place, please expect delays and plan accordingly.

Garbage and recycling should be set out for collection at the normal time and location. Your waste and recycling bins should be marked with the civic address as the constructor may need to carry them to the end of the street and return them if his work operations are blocking access for the collection vehicle.

This is an intrusive construction project, and your patience and cooperation is appreciated.
